



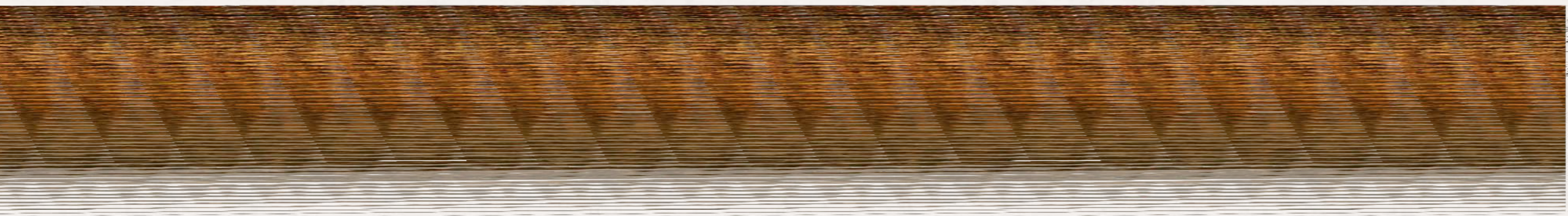

## MEALS:

Three balanced meals daily, prepared to high hygiene and nutrition standards.

Meals feature a variety of authentic and delicious Chinese dishes. Breakfast buffets provide a refreshing start to each day, while lunch and dinner are served in a group dining format or buffet.

## ACCOMMODATION:

Students will stay in local university accommodation within a dedicated building reserved exclusively for the camp.

Each student will have a private single room with their own toilet and bathroom, while 5–6 students will share a common living area.

DBS-checked staff and teachers will stay in the same accommodation building to supervise students and ensure their safety at all times.

All rooms are equipped with air conditioning, and washing machines are available for student use in shared laundry areas.



## SAFETY & CARE

- **24/7 Supervision:** Camp staff stay on-site to provide round-the-clock supervision and support.
- **Experienced Bilingual Team:** Both English and Chinese speaking staff will accompany students at all times.
- **Health & Food Safety:** All meals are freshly prepared, hygienic, and nutritious, with options for different dietary needs (vegetarian, halal, allergies, etc.)
- **Fully Checked Staff:** Every team member is enhanced DBS-checked and trained in child safeguarding and emergency response.
- **Medical Support:** A first-aid-trained staff member is always on duty, and we maintain close contact with local hospitals for any emergencies.
- **24-Hour Contact:** Parents can reach our UK or China support teams at any time during the camp.
- **Insurance Protection:** All students are fully covered by comprehensive travel and health insurance for the duration of the programme.
- **Special Requirements:** If your child has any medical conditions, allergies, or specific needs, please inform us in advance so that we can provide appropriate arrangements and care.
